Why do we baptize?

In the New Testament, baptism is commanded by Jesus for all who trust in him for salvation. Jesus commissioned us to make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit, and teach them to obey all that he has commanded (Mt 28:19-20). This is how we baptize believers still today. Baptism is the first act of obedience to Christ for believers, as we follow Jesus'

example and command. Baptism is a public profession of faith, a sign of fellowship with Christ in his death and resurrection (Rom 6:1-11); of remission of sins (Acts 22:16) and of giving our life to Christ, committing to live and walk in newness of life (Rom 6:4). Baptism is how we say, "I belong to Jesus."
